

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

SUPREME COURT OF APPEALS OF WEST VIRGINIA

RE: REQUEST FOR THE IMPANELING OF A THREE-JUDGE COURT PURSUANT TO WEST VIRGINIA CODE § 6-6-7(c) IN THE PROCEEDING OF IN RE: ROBERT D. NEWELL, MAYOR OF PARKERSBURG, WEST VIRGINIA, WOOD COUNTY CASE NO. 15-P-47

The Honorable J.D. Beane, Chief Judge of the Fourth Judicial Circuit, has forwarded to the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Appeals a copy of the petition filed in the above-styled proceeding, and has requested the impaneling and convening of a three-judge court consisting of three circuit judges of the State, all in accordance with the provisions of West Virginia Code § 6-6-7(c).

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, that the Honorable Omar J. Aboulhosn, Judge of the Ninth Judicial Circuit, the Honorable Lawrance S. Miller Jr., Judge of the Eighteenth Judicial Circuit, and the Honorable Joanna I. Tabit, Judge of the Thirteenth Judicial Circuit, be, and they hereby are, designated and appointed to comprise such three-judge court to be headed by Judge Aboulhosn for the purpose of taking all actions necessary and authorized by West Virginia Code § 6-6-7(c), with such court to be convened at 9:00 a.m. on June 4, 2015, and June 5, 2015, or on an alternate date and/or time set by the three-judge court, in the Circuit Court of Wood County, Wood County Judicial Building, 2 Government Square, Parkersburg, West Virginia, with such hearing to extend thereafter until the referenced matter is concluded.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Circuit Clerk of Wood County record this Order in the Office of said Clerk and provide copies of the same to all parties of record or their counsel.
