#### **Overview**

Orion Strategies executed an interactive voice response phone survey of registered voting age Republicans, Independents, and Non-Party-Affiliated voters across West Virginia to determine preliminary candidate preference in three upcoming primary elections. The poll has a 6% +/- margin of error with a 95% confidence rate and was conducted between June 16 and June 20, 2023.

Note: due to rounding, not all sums will equal 100%


