*ISAIAH BENJAMIN BARKSDALE - DESTRUCTION OF PROPERTY*

On August 4, 2023 at approximately 0338 hours defendant Isaiah Barksdale traveled east on Washington Street East and damaged numerous business and properties. On the Best Western parking lot defendant damaged a red Buick Lacrosse, damaging its driver side window, and large dents, scratches to its driver side front door causing over \$2500 in damage.

At the Clay Center defendant caused damage to the north entry/exit glass door facing Washington Street, and causing approximately \$1500 in damage. The glass door was completely shattered and will need to be replaced.

At the Subway defendant damaged the west facing glass window, shattering and causing a large hole in the window, causing approximately \$1,500 in damage and will need to be replaced.

At the Tudor's defendant caused damage to the east facing glass window, shattering the glass and causing approximately \$2,000 in damages and will need to be replaced.

At the Walgreens defendant shattered and caused a hole in the west facing entry/exit glass door, causing over \$2500 in damages and will need to be replaced.

At the ParMar defendant damaged the north facing glass window, shattering the window and causing over \$2500 in damage and will need to be replaced.

At Moses Cadillac Of Charleston parking lot defendant caused damage to a white GMC Sierra pickup truck. Defendant caused damage to its front driver side window (\$500). While on the Moses lot defendant caused over \$5,000 in extensive damages to a black GMC Sierra pickup truck including deep dents and scratches to its A-pilar, B-pilar, front quarter panel, and hood, all will need to be replaced.

During the commision of the damage stated above, defendnat used a large rock-like piece of asphalt which was used to strike the properties mentioned above. As to the White GMC Sierra a large metal pipe was used to cause damage.

In total defendant caused over \$18,000 in property damage.

Defendant admitted to causing the damage described above.
